Independence and Everyday Living services

These are the most common types of Home Care requested by clients. Experienced Vitalis carers come to your home to provide direct support services like personal care. Our team can also arrange like home modifications on your behalf should you need.

A fee of \$1.50 per kilometre applies for travel in a support worker's vehicle during a care visit.













Sleepover care

If you need it, Vitalis carers can provide care at bedtime and in the morning, staying overnight in your home. As required by legislation, each 12-hour shift includes eight hours of 'inactive care' (sleep from 10pm to 6am) and four hours of 'active care'. Standard hourly care rates apply for any addional 'active care'.


Please note: Vitalis does not charge a joining fee or a one-off assessment fee.

Home Care Package funding

A Home Care Package (HCP) is a government-subsidised program for people over 65 who have more complex needs that provided for by the Commonwealth Home Support Programme (CHSP). The costs listed in this brochure usually come directly from your package subsidy.

Clients may be required to make a contribution to the cost of care by paying an Australian Government income-tested fee. You will not be charged the basic daily fee. Further information about contributions is available on the My Aged Care website.

Here is an estimation of the hours you can receive per your government-determined level if you only choose care delivery (and a base travel average of 7km per visit) and don't include any products, services or exclusive client benefits.

	Hours per week
Level 1	Around 2 hours
Level 2	Around 3 hours
Level 3	Around 9 hours
Level 4	Around 12 hours
